

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-003

A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF RISINGSUN OF THE NECESSITY TO ENACT AN ADDITIONAL FIVE (5) YEAR .5 MILL LEVY IN EXCESS OF THE TEN (10) MILL LIMITATION FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND IMPROVEMENT OF VILLAGE PARK LAND.

WHEREAS, the Village of Risingsun owns, operates, and maintains parks located within the Village for the use and enjoyment of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Risingsun has determined that the amount of monies that may be raised within the ten-mill limitation by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of operating and maintaining the parks within the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Risingsun has determined that in order to continue to maintain and operate said parks, it is necessary to enact an additional levy for a period of five (5) years against all of the real property located within the Village; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code §5705.19(H) permits the collection of such a tax for parks purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Risingsun desires to submit the issue to the residents of the Village at the November 3, 2026 General Election, in compliance with RC §5705.191.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF RISINGSUN, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO, WITH TWO-THIRDS OF ALL MEMBERS VOTING IN FAVOR THEREOF:

SECTION 1: The issue of enacting an additional tax levy against all of the real property located within the Village in the amount of 0.5 mills for each one dollar of valuation for a duration of five (5) years, effective January 1, 2027 to be collected on or after January 1, 2028, for the purposes of operating and maintaining the parks with the Village under RC 5705.19(H) shall be submitted to the voters at the November 3, 2026 General Election.

SECTION 2: The Fiscal Officer of the Village is hereby authorized and directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the Auditor of Wood County, Ohio.

SECTION 3: The Auditor of Wood County, Ohio is hereby requested and authorized to certify to the taxing authority the total current tax valuation of the subdivision and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by such a levy, pursuant to RC §5705.03.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall become effective from and after its passage at the earliest period allowed by Law.

SECTION 5. The Village Fiscal Officer is hereby directed to publish notice of this Ordinance pursuant to RC §731.21.

SECTION 6. All formal actions of Council relating to the adoption of this ordinance, and all deliberations of Council and any of its committees leading to such action were in meetings open to the public as required by law.
