

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-007

A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF RISINGSUN TO SUBMIT TO THE ELECTORS OF THE VILLAGE OF RISINGSUN ON NOVEMBER 3, 2026 THE QUESTION OF APPROVING A RENEWAL OF THE 5 YEAR 6.3 MILL LEVY IN EXCESS OF THE TEN MILL LIMITATION WHICH WAS LAST RENEWED NOVEMBER 2, 2021 TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSES OF THE VILLAGE

WHEREAS, by Resolution 2026-002, the Council of the Village of Risingsun has determined that the amount of monies that may be raised within the ten-mill limitation by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide for the current expenses of the Village; and

WHEREAS, at the general election held on November 8, 2011, the electors of the Village of Risingsun approved a five (5) year, six and three-tenths (6.3) mill levy in excess of the ten (10) mill limitation for the current expenses of the Village; and

WHEREAS, at the general election held on November 7, 2017, the electors of the Village of Risingsun approved a five (5) year renewal of said six and three-tenths (6.3) mill levy in excess of the ten (10) mill limitation for the current expenses of the Village; and

WHEREAS, at the general election held on November 2, 2021, the electors of the Village of Risingsun again approved a five (5) year renewal of said six and three-tenths (6.3) mill levy in excess of the ten (10) mill limitation for the current expenses of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the assessment of the monies generated by said levy were placed on the tax duplicate effective January 1, 2022 and were collected on or after January 1, 2023 and thereafter for a period of five (5) consecutive years; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Risingsun has determined that in order to continue to meet the current expenses of the Village, it is necessary to renew said levy for an additional period of five (5) years against the real property located within the Village; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code §5705.19(A) and RC §5705.191 permit the collection of such a tax for the current expenses of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Wood County Auditor has provided its Certificate of Estimated Property Tax Revenue to the Village as required by law, which certificate states that the property valuation of the Village of Risingsun for purposes of estimating this proposed property tax renewal levy is \$8,441,439.00, and that the proposed six and three-tenths (6.3) mill renewal levy will produce an estimated annual revenue of \$38,079.00 for the life of the levy, provided tax valuations in the Village remain constant throughout the levy.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Risingsun desires to submit the issue to the electors of the Village at the November 3, 2026 General Election, in compliance with RC §5705.191.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF RISINGSUN, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO, WITH TWO-THIRDS OF ALL MEMBERS VOTING IN FAVOR THEREOF:

SECTION 1: That for the purpose of continuing to provide the necessary additional funds for the current expenses of the Village, it is necessary to pass a renewal of the existing, additional five (5) year, six and three-tenths (6.3) mill current expenses levy as authorized by Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.19 (A); that it is necessary to levy said tax outside of the limitations imposed by Section 2, Article XII, of the Ohio Constitution; that said renewal of the now existing additional, five (5) year, six and three-tenths (6.3) current expense levy shall be submitted to the electors of the Village at the general election to be held on November 3, 2026, in order that said levy, if approved by the voters, may be placed on the tax duplicate effective January 1, 2027 to be collected on or after January 1, 2028 and thereafter for a period of five (5) consecutive years.

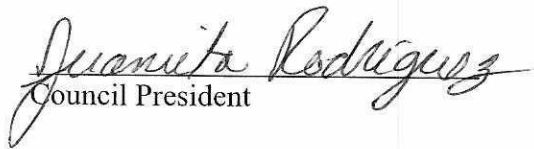
SECTION 2: That the Fiscal Officer of the Village of Risingsun is directed to certify a copy of this resolution, together with a copy of Resolution 2026-002 and the Certificate of Estimated Property Tax Revenue, prepared by the Wood County Auditor, to the Wood County Board of Elections on or before August 4, 2026 at 4:00 pm, in order that this levy issue can be placed on the ballot in the Village of Risingsun for the primary election scheduled for November 3, 2026.

SECTION 3. All formal actions of Council relating to the adoption of this ordinance, and all deliberations of Council and any of its committees leading to such action were in meetings open to the public as required by law.
